The number in each county indicates the number of FTE Primary Care Physicians that are needed to equal $2,500: 1$ ratio.The current ratio for determining need as defined by HRSA is $3,500: 1$, therefore supply may NOT reflect current need in the State of Indiana. A normal work week (e.g. 40 hours) for 1 physician is equivalent 1 FTE.
