



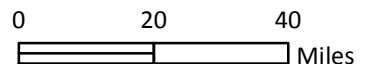
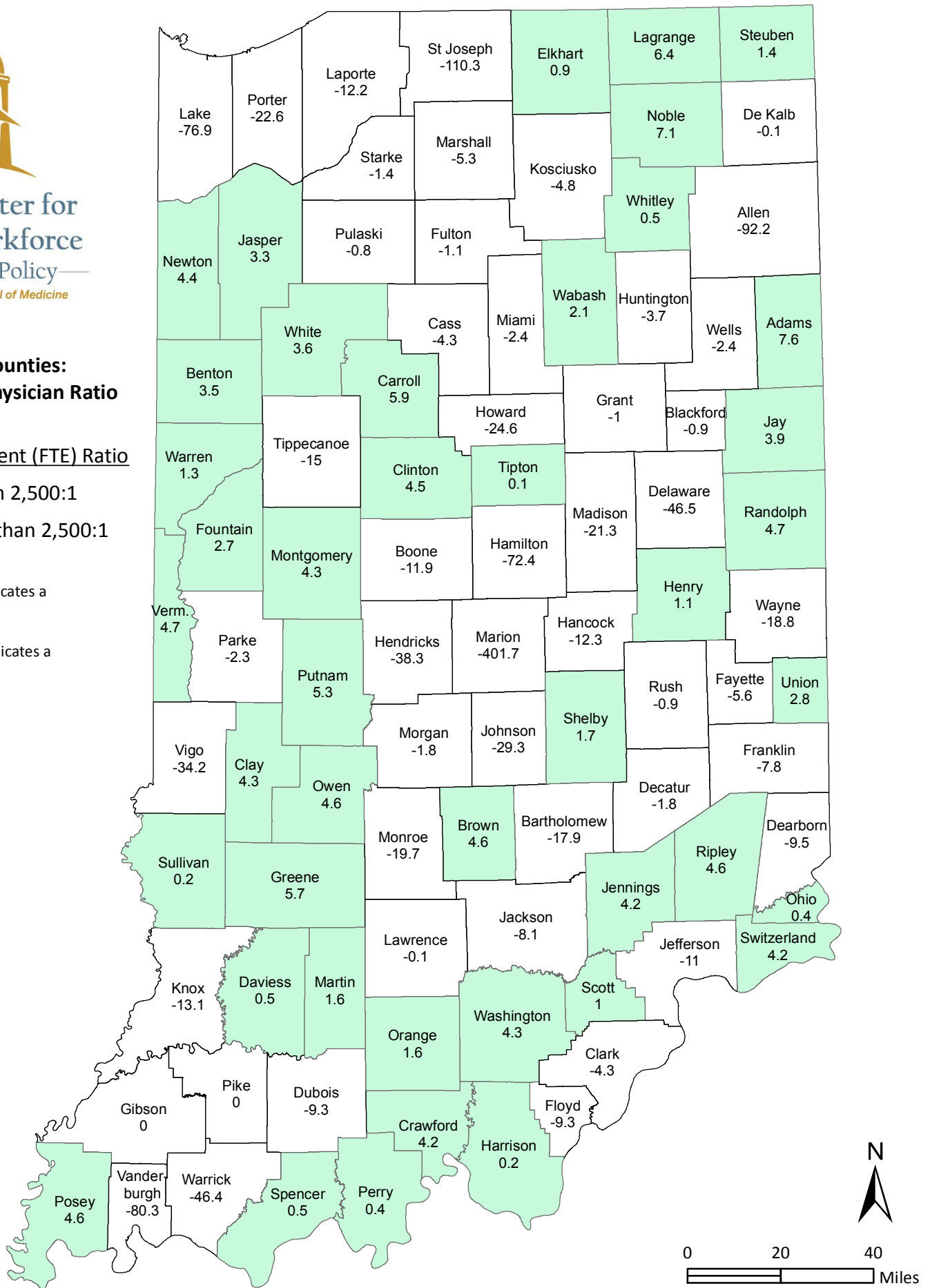
**Indiana Counties:
Primary Care Physician Ratio**

Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Ratio

- Less than 2,500:1
- Greater than 2,500:1

A positive number indicates a need in the county.

A negative number indicates a surplus in the county.

The number in each county indicates the number of FTE Primary Care Physicians that are needed to equal 2,500:1 ratio. The current ratio for determining need as defined by HRSA is 3,500:1, therefore supply may NOT reflect current need in the State of Indiana. A normal work week (e.g. 40 hours) for 1 physician is equivalent 1 FTE.
