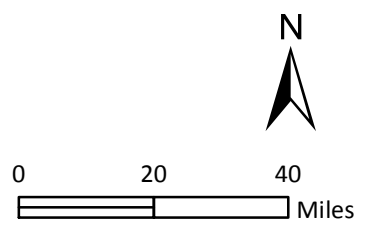
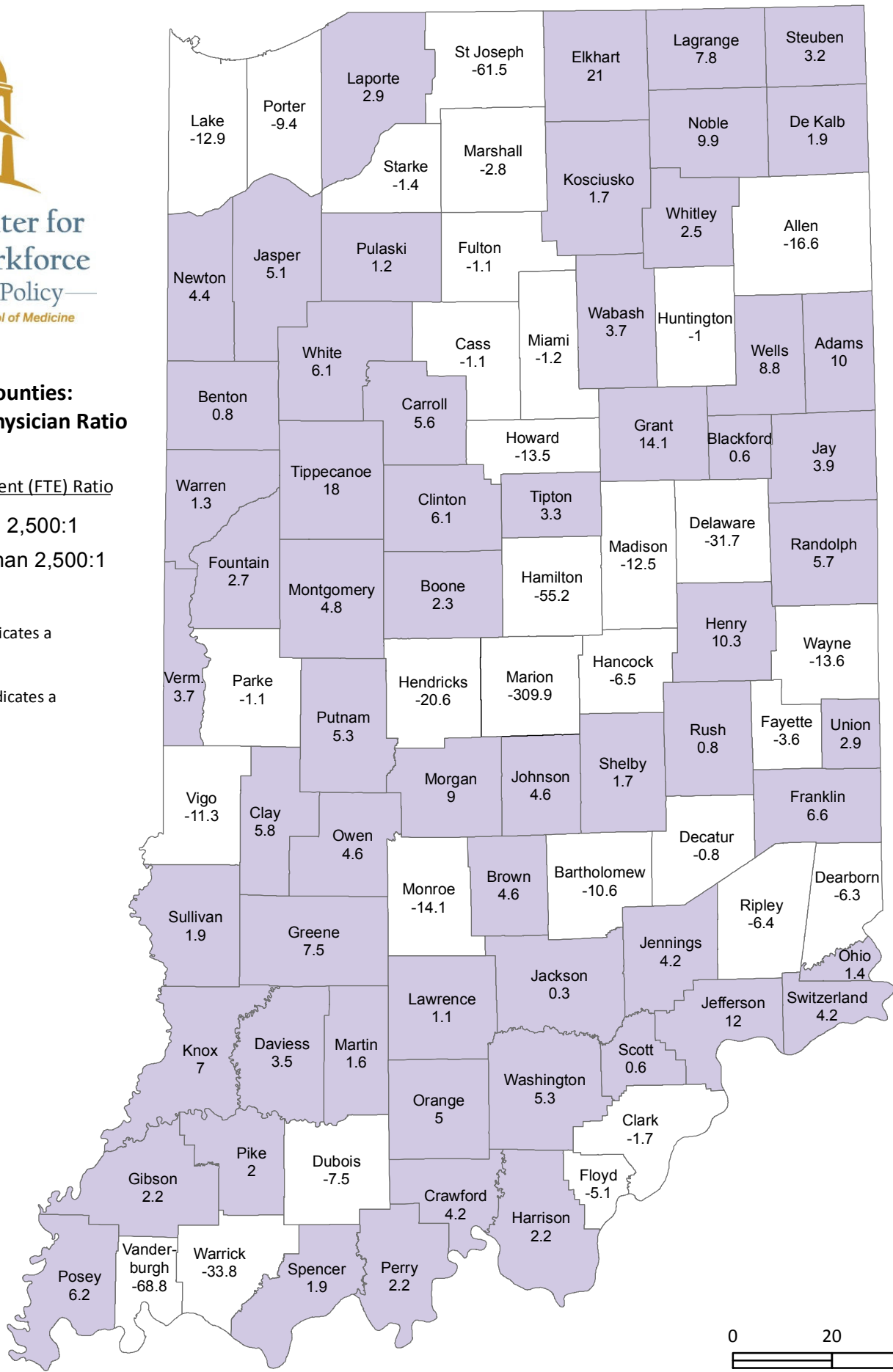
**Indiana Counties:
 Primary Care Physician Ratio**

Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Ratio

- Less than 2,500:1
- Greater than 2,500:1

A positive number indicates a need in the county.

A negative number indicates a surplus in the county.

 Notes: The number in each county indicates the number of FTE Primary Care Physicians that are needed to equal 2,500:1 ratio.

 A normal work week (e.g. 40 hours) for 1 physician is equivalent 1 FTE. Primary Care physician addresses included in the creation of this map have NOT been verified through approved verification practices and only includes the address reported at the time of re-licensure.
